FriendShip Prague, z.s.

is an English-speaking network of Czechs and Expats which exists to provide support and friendship to the homeless and people in need in Prague.

Our story is connected to Help Prague's Homeless, a Facebook group where we first met and volunteered, gathering at the Main Train Station since January 2018.

During Covid, a new way was found to support the homeless people, by a cooperation with local NGOs at Sophie's and Amadeus Humanitarian Hostels where we have been providing food, beverages, toiletries, and other necessities.

Stepping up the commitment, we decided to create FriendShip Prague, z.s. and register it as NGO, becoming an independent and formally established organization in September 2021.

We do not only supply goods but, most importantly, we provide support and Friendship.

Our "**Ship**" is a place where homeless people can always feel welcome, accepted, and safe.

Firstly, **we believe in human** dignity and that all deserve to have their basic needs satisfied, regardless of any life background.

Bringing back that dignity and treating them like humans means so much to them. We believe that these moments of connection and normalcy are seeds for change and a potential rebirth in their life.

We cannot be indifferent to this reality in Prague and, although we cannot change it overnight, we believe in the impact that our action can have, being a strong message to all!



Outreach services

Providing food, drinks, clothes, and essential items to approximately 60 people each week has significantly impacted our community in 2024.

Additionally, we have reached out to the ones sleeping rough on the streets every first Sunday of the month.

Beyond meeting material needs, our efforts to connect with empathy and respect have **instilled a sense of dignity and belonging**,

which is invaluable for individuals experiencing hardship. One good example is our new weekly initiative, the "**WOMEN CLUB"**, to listen to, support and create art with women in need.

While for most for us, Christmas is a time for celebrating, for family, good food and present, for the homeless things are very different. For this reason, we have launched our "Donate a warmer Christmas" campaign, encouraging people to to bring back the true spirit of Christmas by donating trough Darujme, participating to our initiatives and volunteering in person.

In December we organized a free MOVIE AFTERNOON for our friends, kindly hosted by Komunitni Centrum Husitska.

We gathered to watch Pelíšky, we distributed presents, and sweets kindly donated by Artic Bakehouse.

We received over **250 Christmas socks** from individuals and through partnerships, which were distributed at our Christmas Lunch and addittionaly to Nadeje. We will also keep distributing the socks during our montly winter walks to donate warm socks stuffed with sweets and travel size toiletries to the ones sleeping rough on the streets.

Additionally, Yoga with Karina offered a charity class at The Little Mole school, where we raised 27.136 CZK thanks to the kind donations of the participants that allowed us to provide **a traditional Czech Christmas meal**, as well as **new gloves and new neck warmers, for 100 homeless** friends.

The yoga lesson was followed by a delicious breakfast kindly donated by Timelesssourdough bakery.



This year we were fortunate to have our **traditional Christmas meal indoor, in the beautiful Fortna,** a former monastery in which our Friends enjoyed a warm meal and an amazing event and a concert offered by the amazing singer Metha.

Our volunteers brought an inspiring spirit of generosity and care, dedicating their time and attention to create shared moments that touched hearts and lifted spirits. Their selfless actions remind us of the profound impact we can have on the lives of our Friends, especially during this season of giving and connection.
